

- Enjoy green scenery, young wildlife and fewer crowds in the reserves of Kenya and Tanzania.

July to September

- Witness part of the famous Great Migration in Tanzania's southern Serengeti and Kenya's Maasai Mara.
- Encounter majestic southern right whales off the coast of South Africa in Hermanus.
- July and August are cool and dry, making it an ideal time to explore Madagascar.

October to December

- Birdlife comes alive across southern Africa in the Okavango Delta and Greater Kruger National Park.
