

DAY 11 CRUISE INSIDE PASSAGE, ALASKA

GLACIAL FJORDS & GRAND FORESTS

Alaska's Inside Passage is a protected network of waterways that wind through glacier-cut fjords and lush rain forests along the rugged coast of Southeast Alaska. Arguably one of the greatest cruising routes in the world, the Inside Passage stretches through Misty Fjords National Monument, famed Glacier Bay National Park & Preserve. (B,L,D)

DAY 12 CRUISE TRACY ARM-JUNEAU, ALASKA

COASTAL CLIFFS & THE CATCH OF THE DAY

Steep cliffs and glacier-covered mountains flank the Tracy Arm fjord, fringed by the largest intact coastal temperate rainforest in the United States. Old-growth trees colonised Tracy Arm's mouth long ago as the Ice Age retreated. Continue cruising to Juneau, Alaska and visit the most remote state capital in the United States. Visitors in Juneau can hike a glacier, eat fresh-caught fish on a seaside patio and tour a grand capitol building all in one day. (B,L,D)

DAY 13 SKAGWAY

THE RUSH FOR GOLD

At the height of the Klondike Gold Rush, the port town of Skagway served as the primary gateway to the legendary gold fields, and quickly grew into Alaska's largest settlement. It was then a raucous frontier hub packed with trading posts, saloons, and guesthouses. As the gold rush faded into the 1900s, so did Skagway—but today it has been reinvigorated as a gateway for a new kind of visitor: those looking to explore Alaska's colourful history, pristine wildlife, and unrivaled natural beauty. (B,L,D)

DAY 14 CRUISE GLACIER BAY NATIONAL PARK

ICE DANCING

On your cruise to Glacier Bay (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), close your eyes and take in the sounds—the creaks and groans of “living” ice, the shrill cries of gulls and soaring eagles, the splash of a breaching humpback whale. Frosted peaks towering over mossy forests, wide tidewater glaciers

(there are seven in the park), and frequent wildlife sightings on Glacier Bay cruises are just a few of the thrilling experiences in this unique and beautiful biosphere. (B,L,D)

DAY 15 KETCHIKAN

PORT OF CALL
