



① Mt. Kenya / Ol Pejeta Conservancy

Hidden gem of baobab-dotted landscapes and wildlife thriving along the Tarangire River.

⑧ Volcanoes National Park

A misty mountain refuge for endangered gorillas, towering peaks, and lush rainforests.

Witness it during a picnic in Ngorongoro Crater, on private game drives with expert guides at home in the bush, aboard a hot-air balloon ride at dawn that views the migrating herds from on high, and during quiet moments at the end of the day, when sundowner toasts and incredible star-filled skies remind you just how amazing Africa is. ① Skeleton Coast National Park

Where the Atlantic meets towering desert dunes, a wilderness of shipwrecks and resilient wildlife thrives.

② Ongava Game Reserve

An exclusive safari sanctuary where rugged wilderness meets pioneering conservation and refined luxury.

③ Etosha National Park

Shimmering salt plains stretch along vast open plains, abundant with wildlife, from elephants to black rhinos.

④ NamibRand Nature Reserve

A "sea of sand" where oryx, zebras, and jackals roam beneath some of Earth's darkest, star-filled skies.

⑤ Kalahari Desert

Endless red dunes whisper a quiet resilience, where black-maned lions prowl, meerkats stand still, and ancient San cultures have thrived for millennia.

⑥ Okavango Delta

One of Africa's most diverse ecosystems – emerald waterways meet mopane woodlands and floodplains.

⑦ Chobe National Park

Renowned for its vast wildlife diversity, particularly its large elephant population, and its stunning landscapes of floodplains, savannas, and dense forests.

⑧ Makgadikgadi Basin

One of the world's largest salt pans, a vast expanse of raw and haunting beauty shaped by wind and time.

⑨ Victoria Falls National Park

A UNESCO World Heritage Site recognized as the largest waterfall in the world, bordering Zimbabwe and Zambia.

⑩ Ngala Private Game Reserve

Teeming with breeding herds of elephants, leopards, spotted hyenas, giraffes, and white rhinos.

⑪ Kruger National Park

One of Africa's most legendary game reserves – vast, untamed, and home to the iconic "Big Five," roaming freely across diverse landscapes.

⑫ Kapama Private Game Reserve

Africa's wilderness is always calling, but each season offers a unique spectacle. Witness the Great Migration's thundering herds in East Africa or South Africa's dry-season gatherings at watering holes. From newborn animals taking their first steps to predators on the hunt, every moment brings something extraordinary - this guide will help you find the right safari and season for you.

Eastern Africa, dual seasons

East Africa's tropical climate, shaped by its equatorial location and altitude, offers two rainy and two dry seasons, making it a year-round safari destination. From June to October, the Great Migration sees wildebeest and zebras crossing rivers, while December to March brings calving season, attracting big cats and heightened wildlife activity.

Southern Africa, contrasting seasons

Southern Africa's subtropical climate varies widely, creating distinct safari seasons. The "green season" (October – March) brings lush landscapes, fewer crowds, and newborn wildlife, while the "dry season" (April – September) offers prime game viewing as animals gather at water sources. Beyond safaris, enjoy cultural tours, marine adventures, and year-round exploration.


